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The **FINAVESTAN white oils** can be used in a variety of industries: Pharmaceuticals & Cosmetics, Plastics & Rubber and Food.

It is important to note that the application is subject to the applicable laws and regulations **in each country**. Therefore, the FINAVESTAN user must check compliance with applicable regulations of the concerned country.

Thus, only FINAVESTAN A 360 B and FINAVESTAN A 520 B comply with the Regulation EU No 10/2011.
